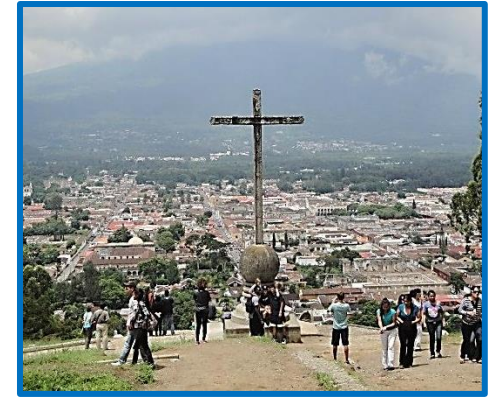

Since 2002 we have been leading a group of pilgrims from around the country on a 10-day work pilgrimage to Guatemala.

This will be our 14th visit to the highland province of Chimaltenango, supporting the mission of PAVA (Programa de Ayuda a los Vecinos del Altiplano) as it helps Mayan villagers with local community development projects to improve their lives and opportunities.

We go with open hands, expecting to be changed.
