

Visioning Seekers for 2017 –

- 1) Integrate new people more deeply.
- 2) Explicit teaching/preaching about Seekers vocabulary and practice.
- 3) Make greater use of informal spiritual companions.
- 4) Consider greater social justice advocacy as a response to election. We live now at the intersection of the political and the theological.
- 5) What does C of S mean for us? Include in our thinking about this question other congregations around country who try to use the C of S as a model.
- 6) Caring for those in our community who are aging and separate from family?
- 7) Shift anxiety to embracing joy.
- 8) Explore alternative preaching: dance, Interplay, clowns.
- 9) Be proactive not reactive. Classes here are a possibility.
- 10) Develop a theological basis for why we need to be caring.
- 11) Learn how to equip ourselves for offering undergirding support.
- 12) Dealing with aging within Seekers.
- 13) Work with how we use time and money.
- 14) Develop more connections to Dayspring/Wellspring.
- 15) Need for corporate rituals for endings, e.g. laying down the call of Kononia.
- 16) How can Stewards support SLT pastoral work?
- 17) Encourage SLT to ask others for help.
